These data must be certified by July 31, 2009. 	
VR11 -timely evaluation of preschool and school-age students for eligibility determinations for special education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All preschool and school age students for whom parent's consent to evaluate was received by the CPSE or CSE between July 1, 2008 and June 30, 2009. Includes all referrals from Early Intervention and all referrals of students parentally placed in nonpublic schools. 	Special Education Events data elements – status of students as of August 31, 2009
VR12 -IEPs by their 3 rd birthday for children transitioning from Early Intervention to preschool special education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All preschool students referred from Early Intervention between July 1, 2008 and June 30, 2009. 	Special Education Events data elements – status of students as of August 31, 2009
VR13 -preschool programs and services for children with disabilities any time during the 2008-09 school year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All preschool children with disabilities who received special education programs and services between July 1, 2008 and June 30, 2009. Include preschool children who received summer services in July and August 2008 before becoming school-age students in September 2009. Ensure enrollment period and preschool disability program service period have some over-lap. Enrollment code 4034 is not an appropriate code to report children who received preschool special education programs and services. The 4034 enrollment code can only precede the “0011” or “5905” enrollment codes. 	End-of-Year Special Education Snapshot data elements

VR15 -preschool outcomes of preschool children on the Child Outcomes Summary Form (COSF) in three early childhood outcome areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All preschool children with disabilities who ended preschool special education between July 1, 2008 and June 30, 2009.
